What was the biggest design challenge in this 1,200-square-foot Saddle River kitchen? “Taking a huge space and making it cozy and easy to use,” says Amir Ilin of Küche+Cucina, Paramus. “We built three islands and used five different colors. In the end, it really worked.”

- 1 Coffered ceilings with handmade tile and relief inserts.
- 2 Jerusalem stone flooring in a four-piece pattern from Mediterranean Tile & Marble.
- 3 Sinks by Herbeau and Franke, faucets by Rohl.
- 4 Pot rack by Howard Kaplan.
- 5 Backsplash from Mediterranean Tile & Marble.
